1. Welcome Opening: Kari Rivera

- Description of the function of Sports Boosters– Sports Boosters is each team’s accountant that manages the money for all 23 teams. Each team has their account and raises its own money. Sports Boosters is the banking arm for each team, taking the deposits and putting them into each team’s account. Each coach draws on their account for team expenses. Sports Boosters provides each coach with a ledger of income received, withdrawn, and the balance for their respective team. Each team has control over their team’s money. Sports Boosters have only \$10, 000 in their account for operating expenses.
- Sports Boosters sponsors 2 fundraisers. The first fundraiser is the sale of Blue & Gold Cards. This card is purchased for \$110 and allows families to get into all gated sporting events at Oak Ridge for the school year. The only exceptions are playoffs. The Blue & Gold Card memberships are a matching fundraiser. This means that each team will receive up to

\$1,000 for participation of purchasing cards by team families. The second fundraiser is the Blue& Gold Auction and Dinner. All 23 teams are expected to participate and the money raised from this event is disbursed based on team participation. The money raised from each of these fundraisers is directly deposited into each team account and the coach is notified of this amount in his/her account.

- Sports Boosters provides and pays for physical therapy services to Oak Ridge team athletes. Specifically, El Dorado Hills Physical Therapy is paid \$9,000 per year in exchange for each and every student athlete to receive up to 2 free visits. After the initial 2 free visits, the student athlete pays only \$25 per visit. This is a service provided to every team, every level. Rueben, the physical therapist, is on campus 2-3 times a week.
